**Notice of Proposed Changes to Local Rules including Caseload Allocation Plan

In accordance with Trial Rule 81 of the Indiana Rules of Court, the Madison Unified Circuit Courts hereby give notice to the bar and the public that the Courts propose to amend the existing local rules, including a proposed new caseload allocation at LR 48-AR 00-07. All new text is shown by underlining and deleted text is shown by ~~striketrough~~. Supreme Court approval is required for Local Rules concerning Trial Rule 81 and may not take effect until approved by the Supreme Court.

The time period for the bar and the public to comment will begin on **February 1, 2013** and will close on **March 1, 2013**. The proposed amendments to the rules will be adopted, modified or rejected before **March 15, 2013**; and, the final version of the rules will be submitted to the Indiana Supreme Court for review and approval.
