RE: Reconstruction/Maintenance Assessments for Thompson,  
Minnick, Bevelheimer And Johnston Regulated Drain

**ORDER**

Comes now the Madison County Drainage Board, and after conducting a duly noticed public hearing on March 23, 2017, and hearing all timely filed written objections and hearing additional oral evidence at the Public Hearing, now finds the following with regard to the maintenance or reconstruction of the Thompson, Minnick, Bevelheimer and Johnston Regulated Drain ("TMBJ Drain"):

1. The Board adopts the findings presented by Banning Engineering found in the February 3, 2016, "Condition Report and Reconstruction/Maintenance Recommendations for Thompson, Minnick, Bevelheimer, and Johnston Regulated Drain," presented to the Drainage Board on March 22, 2017 as well as the oral presentation made at the Public Hearing by Banning Engineering's Engineer, Jeff Healy.

2. The Board determines that reconstruction of the TMBJ Drain is not cost-effective but that maintenance of the TMBJ Drain is cost effective at the rates described below.

3. The assessment rates of:

Open	\$10/acre/year,
Thompson	\$25/acre/year,
Minick	\$25/acre/year,
Bevelheimer	\$25/acre/year,
Johnston	\$25/acre/year,

are hereby adopted as they are sufficient to maintain the TMBJ Drain.

4. Lots less than one acre in size, and affected by more than one legal drain, shall have an annual assessment not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

5. The schedule of assessments attached hereto which reflect the annual assessment rates above is hereby adopted without amendment, except as to required by Federal regulations as described at the public hearing on March 23, 2017.
